High School President

- A. Represent the student body at the school and at community events and other meetings.
- B. Be responsible for coordinating the interviewing, selection and functioning of the student council.
- C. Supervise the functioning of the elected student body officers.
- D. Develop the agenda for and preside over the meetings of Student Council.

High School Vice-President

- A. Represent the student body at the school and at community events and other meetings.
- B. Coordinate the work of the student council with the president.
- C. Preside over Student Council meetings in the absence of the president.

High School Secretary

- A. Maintain the student body files.
- B. Prepare agendas for meetings.
- C. Take and distribute minutes of meetings.
- D. Represent the student body at the school and at community events and other meetings.
- E. Create and develop material for Student Council as needed.
- F. Sign all expense request orders.
- G. Coordinate the on-campus student store with the treasurer.

High School Treasurer

- A. Coordinate the preparation of the annual budget.
- B. Present the proposed budget to Student Council and principal for adoption.
- C. Maintain financial records of the student body.
- D. Prepare financial reports for meetings of Student Council.
- E. Assist the principal with sales as necessary.
- F. Coordinate fund raising projects for the student body.
- G. Sign all expense request orders.

H. Coordinate the on-campus student store with the secretary.

High School Historian

- A. Gather materials in preparation for the Student Council Scrapbook.
- B. Be responsible for the completion of the scrapbook.
- C. Maintain a file of materials about activities of the school.
- D. Make sure pictures are taken of all activities.
- E. Coordinate work on other historical presentations (i.e., video).
- F. Help the principal with posting on social media outlets for the school.

High School Parliamentarian

- A. Provide advice on questions of parliamentary procedure.
- B. Make the Council members aware of good parliamentary practices.

Middle School Jr. President

- A. Assistant to the High School president.

Middle School Jr. Vice-President

- A. Assistant to the High School vice-president.

Middle School Jr. Secretary

- A. Assistant to the High School secretary.

Middle School Treasurer

- A. Assistant to the High School treasurer.

Middle School Jr. Historian

- A. Assistant to the High School historian.

Middle School Jr. Parliamentarian

- A. Assistant to the High School parliamentarian.
