

# No cell phones.

We know it's intimidating to feel disconnected. But your student will greatly benefit from removing the distractions that come with texting, social media, etc.

Cell phones are permitted on the van ride to the campus and the van ride home. Phones will be collected when we arrive at the church campus and kept safely during the remainder of the week.



# Helpful Hints

## **1. Know the safety policies and procedures.**

We will ensure that every student is accounted for and safe during the duration of the trip. Should you have an EMERGENCY, call 817-773-1253.

All students are expected to lead by being honest, caring, positive, helpful, respectful, and display honoring behavior to others.

\*If a questionable, unsafe, or inappropriate situation arises, staff will determine the appropriate course of action. This could include students being sent home at the student/parent's expense.

## **2. Be prepared.**

You can do this by helping your student stick to the packing list, following us on social media and saving the emergency number in your phone. You never know when something will happen, and you need to contact us quickly.

All parents will be added to a parent group chat in the app called "Group Me." We will update this chat with any important information like when we are leaving.

## **3. Be flexible.**

We know it can be nerve-racking to send your student away for a week. Every decision was prayerfully considered. We have planned and prepared better than we ever have to make sure the mission trip is safe and fun! Generation 4:12 has been a staple in our church for years. We are always learning, but we have already learned a lot.

## **4. Be expectant.**

Prayer from home has the power to change the game during the Generation 4:12 trip. Join us in praying for salvation, leadership growth, and for students to experience the power of the presence of God!

# Requirements to Attend Trip

- Make a solid commitment to attend the trip. The cost is determined by the amount of space we have per person. When you sign up you are entering into a commitment to attend!
- Students must have completed 4th grade by the end of the 2018-2019 school year.
- All attendees are expected to follow the expectations and respect the authority over them at all times.
- Students must not be a discipline problem at home, school, or church.
- Can students invite friends who don't attend Barefoot Church to be a part of this mission trip? Absolutely! As long as they meet the requirements to attend, turn in all completed registration paperwork, and pay their deposit before spots are taken.

# Dress Code

We want everyone to focus on Jesus, so we ask everyone to dress appropriately.

## **Specifics for ladies:**


- No bikinis. Appropriate swim options include tankinis that cover your stomach, a one piece without massive cutouts, or a dark tank top over your two-piece.
- Tank tops with straps less than two fingers wide should not be packed.
- No short shorts.
- No low cut shirts.
- No crop tops.

## **Specifics for guys:**

- No Speedos.
- No clothing with inappropriate language or illegal substances on it.
- No super tight-fitting shirts.

## **Other clothing specifics:**

- Students will be given a Generation 4:12 shirt the day we leave
- Clothes for 6 days with extra sets of clothes as it will be HOT and students may want to change after returning from the mission site.
- Pajamas, underwear and socks - they're important. Pack enough for 6 days plus extra for middle of the day changes.
- Tennis shoes or other closed toed shoes are a must for the mission site, sandals can be worn at other appropriate times including activities outside of the mission site.
- Ziploc bags are great for clean clothes that are labeled per day/activity
- Grocery type plastic bags work great for daily packing and later for collection of dirty clothes. Another great way to store dirty clothes is using the Ziploc bags.



# Packing List

Everything you pack must fit in two bags max (one suitcase and one backpack).

## What To Pack:

- Bible
- Notebook
- Pens
- Deflated air mattress
- Blanket
- Sheet Set
- Pillow
- Toiletries (soap, shampoo, deodorant, toothbrush, toothpaste, etc.)
- Lip balm with SPF
- Sunscreen
- Insect repellent
- Money for additional snacks
- Comfortable and dress code appropriate clothing
- Swimsuit that is dress code appropriate
- Bath towel
- Swimming towel
- Washcloths
- Brush, ponytail holders, hair accessories
- Hat and sunglasses
- Refillable water bottle
- Snacks (in gallon size baggies)
- Extra spending money to purchase food and other items at the night-time activity on Thursday
- Prescription and over the counter medications, if necessary. (A medication card will be filled out by the parent for each medication the child is taking. A staff member will administer all medications).
- Games to play during free time (must fit inside luggage)





## What Not To Pack:

- Items that CANNOT get dirty, wet, or are irreplaceable if damaged or lost
- Tobacco products, alcohol, or drugs\*\*
- Weapons\*\*
- Fireworks\*\*
- Lighters or matches\*\*
- Pranks\*\*
- Vape pens\*\*
- Water balloons or water guns
- Cell phones, iPads, Apple Watches, laptops, gaming devices, etc. (these can be used on ride up and back, but they will be collected and locked up during the duration of the week).
- Jewelry or anything of value
- Clothing that is not dress code appropriate

\*\*We will confiscate any of these items. If a student is in possession of any starred items, the Life Development pastor will be immediately notified and respond accordingly.

# Departure & Arrival

July 7: Drop off is immediately after the 11:00 experience at the lower kids building. Luggage can be dropped off any time before then on Sunday. We'll eat lunch together, clean the facilities, and then head out.

July 13: Pick up is 1:30 PM at Barefoot Church.
